Committee Activities: The major activities include:

- Continuation and completion of review of the Michigan Family Law Bench book published by ICLE. Committee members provided input on revisions to the Bench book to ensure that appropriate text and/or cross-references are in the text concerning the Indian Child Welfare, Tribal jurisdiction over family law matters (i.e. support; custody; paternity).
- Other activities included work on drafting recommendations for revisions to Michigan Court Rules pertaining to Indian Child Welfare Act matters. Ultimately, it was determined to suspend Committee action in this area due to overlap with efforts undertaken by the Supreme Court Administrator's Office (SCAO). Committee members were encouraged to participate in the SCAO Subcommittee working on these issues.
- The Committee also discussed contributions to future issues of the Michigan Bar Journal. Committee member Ezekial Fletcher was instrumental in securing the February 2010 future edition with an Indian Law theme.

Future Goals and Activities:

- Continue efforts to monitor drafting of revisions to Michigan Court Rules designed to implement responsibilities under the Indian Child Welfare Act.
- Continue to develop relationships with other Committees/Sections within the Bar to raise the profile/familiarity with Indian Law and the role/jurisdiction of Indian tribes and Tribal Courts in the State.
