Committee Activities:

- The committee provided testimony to the House Judiciary Committee regarding HB 4909
 (Tobocman) "Electronic Recording of Certain Custodial Interrogation Sessions" in 2007.
 The committee has worked on drafting legislation for recording custodial interrogations for this legislative session.
- 2. The committee continued implementation of the pilot cites. Departments adopted the State Bar Model Policy on Recording Custodial Interrogation. Audio/Visual Recording equipment was installed in the following locations:

- 3. Katherine Knight finished the analysis of the Jackson County Site and prepared the first part of the findings and report.
- 4. Barbara O'Brien, MSU Law School Professor, joined the consulting team to replace Katherine Knight.

Future Goals and Activities: Continue gathering data from the Pilot project sites with the help of a skilled research team from University of Michigan; Professor Sam Gross, Professor Pheobe Ellsworth, and MSU Law Professor Barbara O'Brien. Finalize draft legislation.
