NOTE: Following approval of nominations, all newly appointed members' terms will be <u>for</u> the March 27, 2010 and September 30, 2010 meetings only. You must fill out and submit your petition for election to finish your term.

Individuals appointed to fill vacancies with terms expiring at the close of the 2010 Annual Meeting are interim appointees. In order to retain the Assembly seat for a new three-year term (expiring 2013), interim appointees MUST submit a completed Assembly Petition to the State Bar of Michigan by April 30, 2010.

Individuals appointed to fill vacancies with terms expiring at the close of the 2011 or 2012 Annual Meeting are interim appointees whose terms are only effective for the March 27, 2010 and the September 30, 2010 meetings. The reminder of the term will be open for election. Interim appointees MUST submit a completed Assembly Petition to the State Bar of Michigan by April 30, 2010 in order to retain the Assembly seat through 2011 or 2012.
