#### **Other Section Activities:**

- 1. ILS publishes the *Michigan International Lawyer* three times a year with assistance from Wayne State University School of Law. The mission of the *Michigan International Lawyer* is to enhance and contribute to the public's knowledge of world law and trade with articles of contemporary international law topics and issues of general interest. The journal is mailed to all Section members and is also available on the Section's website at michbar.org/international.
- 2. ILS sponsored the *2007 International Law Student Essay Contest*. The contest is open to all law students enrolled at any Michigan law school. ILS offers a first prize of \$750 and a second place prize of \$250 to the students who write the best original essays on a topic selected by judges.
- 3. ILS created an ad-hoc Strategic Planning Committee comprised of current ILS Officers and former Section Chairs. This committee met several times to discuss the direction of the Section over the next 5 years. The proposed plan will be presented to the Council at the June 21, 2007 Regular Meeting of the Council.
- 4. ILS created an ad-hoc Bylaw Review Committee to review and proposed amendments to the Section Bylaws. The proposed amendments have been approved by the ILS Council and will be presented to the Section for approval at the September 2007 Annual Meeting of the Section.
- 5. The ILS Council approved changes to the ILS Standing Committees resulting in (a) the consolidation of the International Business Law Committee and the International Tax Committee into one committee renamed the International Business and Tax Law Committee; (b) the elimination of 3 committees; (c) the renaming of 2 other committee to more accurately reflect substantive topics covered by such committees; and (d) the creation of a new committee, the International Human Rights Law Committee. In addition, the ILS Council adopted defined responsibilities for volunteers serving as Chair or Co-Chair of any ILS Standing Committee.

### Article VIII, § 1

Every Section and State Bar entity so directed by the Board of Commissioners or Representative Assembly shall annually make a written report containing a summary of its activities during the association year which shall be submitted to the Secretary on or before May 31. Annual reports may not exceed five 8 1/2'' x 11'' pages unless a waiver of this limitation is approved by the Executive Director.
