

## MEMORANDUM

Rule 6, Section 6 of the Supreme Court Rules Concerning the State Bar of Michigan provides that any vacancy in the membership of the Assembly shall be filled by appointment of the Assembly's membership upon nomination of the remaining representatives from the judicial circuit or, if there are none, the State Bar recognized local bar association in the judicial circuit. The Assembly's Nominating & Awards Committee is responsible for soliciting and presenting nominations to the Assembly.

There are vacancies in the following judicial circuits for the current Bar year, for which the lawyers listed below are nominated. All interim appointees will serve for the September 2018 and April 2019 meetings only. To fill the remaining term thereafter, an interim appointee will need to file an election petition and stand for election.

5th Judicial Circuit: 1 interim appointment lasting through the September 2018 meeting to a vacancy for a term that expires at the close of the 2018 Annual Meeting.

6th Judicial Circuit: 1 interim appointment lasting through the September 2018 meeting to a vacancy for a term that expires at the close of the 2018 Annual Meeting.

16th Judicial Circuit: 1 interim appointment lasting through the September 2018 meeting to a vacancy for a term that expires at the close of the 2018 Annual Meeting.

1 interim appointment lasting through the September 2019 meeting to a vacancy for a term that expires at the close of the 2019 Annual Meeting.
