Proposed Standard for Determining Indigency anad Contribution

The MIDC proposes this minimum standard for making indigency determinations for those local funding units that elect to assume the responsibility of appointing counsel and for setting the amount that a partially indigent defendant must contribute to their defense.

POSITION: Support with amendments to the "Indigency Determination" section to increase the rebuttable presumption for indigency from 140% to 200% of the federal poverty guidelines and to add "transcripts and other case-related expenses" as qualifying costs under subsection (f).
