2006-06 - Proposed Amendment of Rule 7.215 of the Michigan Court Rules

The September 18, 2007, proposed amendment of MCR 7.215 reflects revisions recommended by the Michigan Court of Appeals. The amendment would shift responsibility for making an "outcome-determinative" assessment from the entire bench to the panel deciding the case in which the conflict is raised. The amendment would also require the panel to state the disposition it would have reached had it not been required to follow the prior published decision.
