On order of the Court, the application for leave to appeal the April 2, 2020 judgment of the Court of Appeals is considered and, pursuant to MCR 7.305(H)(1), in lieu of granting leave to appeal, we VACATE that part of the judgment of the Court of Appeals addressing the trial court's assessment of court costs pursuant to MCL 769.1k(1)(b)(iii), and we REMAND this case to the Court of Appeals, which shall hold this case in abeyance pending its decision in *People v Lewis* (Court of Appeals Docket No. 350287). After *Lewis* is decided, the Court of Appeals shall reconsider this case in light of *Lewis*. In all other respects, leave to appeal is DENIED, because we are not persuaded that the remaining questions presented should be reviewed by this Court.

We do not retain jurisdiction.
