By order of January 31, 2022, the application for leave to appeal the August 12, 2021 judgment of the Court of Appeals was held in abeyance pending the decisions in *People v Posey* (Docket No. 162373) and *People v Stewart* (Docket No. 162497). On order of the Court, *Posey* having been decided on July 31, 2023, 512 Mich ___ (2023), and *Stewart* having been decided on July 31, 2023, 512 Mich ___ (2023), the application is again considered. Pursuant to MCR 7.305(H)(1), in lieu of granting leave to appeal, we VACATE the judgment of the Court of Appeals to the extent that it is inconsistent with our decision in *Posey* and REMAND this case to that court for reconsideration in light of *Posey*. In all other respects, leave to appeal is DENIED, because we are not persuaded that the remaining questions presented should be reviewed by this Court.

We do not retain jurisdiction.
