Public Policy Position HB 5751

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is a voluntary membership section of the State Bar of Michigan, comprised of 1,121 members. The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Elder Law & Disability Rights Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. To date, the State Bar does not have a position on this item.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section has a public policy decision-making body with 20 members. On June 4, 2022, the Section adopted its position after a discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 18 members voted in favor of the Section's position, 0 members voted against this position, 0 members abstained, 2 members did not vote.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section opposes HB 5751 because it does not comport with current HUD regulations, creates a too narrow definition of doctor-patient relationship for tenant applicants, and ignores non-ESA assistance animals creating an unfair barrier for individuals with mental or psychological needs.
