Public Policy Position SB 0204

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is a voluntary membership section of the State Bar of Michigan, comprised of 1,121 members. The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Elder Law & Disability Rights Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. To date, the State Bar does not have a position on this item.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section has a public policy decision-making body with 20 members. On April 12, 2023, the Section adopted its position after a discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 13 members voted in favor of the Section's position, 0 members voted against this position, 1 member abstained, 6 members did not vote.

The section finds the bill to be overly broad, recognizes there are other statutes that provide protections to vulnerable adults, and the bill could have unintended consequences for vulnerable adults.
