

ELDER LAW & DISABILITY RIGHTS SECTION

Public Policy Position HB 5032

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is a voluntary membership section of the State Bar of Michigan, comprised of 1,178 members. The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Elder Law & Disability Rights Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. To date, the State Bar does not have a position on this item.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section has a public policy decisionmaking body with 19 members. On May 5, 2018, the Section adopted its position after a discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 15 members voted in favor of the Section's position on HB 5032, 0 members voted against this position, 0 members abstained, 4 members did not vote.
