#### Bill Numbers:

<u>HB 4170</u> (Tedder) Health; other; physician orders for scope of treatment forms; allow. Amends sec. 20919 of <u>1978</u> <u>PA 368</u> (MCL <u>333.20919</u>) & adds pt. 56B & sec. 20192a.

HB 4171 (Cox) Probate; guardians and conservators; physician orders for scope of treatment form; authorize a guardian to sign. Amends secs. 1106, 5303, 5305 & 5314 of <u>1998 PA 386</u> (MCL <u>700.1106</u> et seq.).

<u>HB 4173</u> (Vaupel) Human services; adult foster care; physician orders for scope of treatment form; establish procedure if adult foster care facility is unwilling to comply with the form. Amends secs. 6 & 26a of <u>1979 PA 218</u> (MCL <u>400.706</u> & <u>400.726a</u>) & adds sec. 26c.

<u>HB 4174</u> (Love) Health; emergency response; procedure for complying with a do-not-resuscitate order; revise to reflect physician orders for scope of treatment forms. Amends sec. 11 of <u>1996 PA 193</u> (MCL <u>333.1061</u>) & adds sec. 11a.

#### Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

The Elder and Disability Rights Section of the State Bar of Michigan supports House Bills 4170-4174 provided that Section 5676(1)(A)(vi) of House Bill 4170 is amended as follows:

(n) A STATEMENT THAT FOR THE POST FORM TO REMAIN IN EFFECT, THE POST FORM MUSTSHOULD BE REVIEWED, DATED, AND INITIALED BY EITHER THE-ATTENDING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL AND THE PATIENT OR THE ATTENDING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL AND THE PATIENT REPRESENTATIVE, IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING HAVE OCCURRED:
(A) ONE YEAR HAS EXPIRED SINCE THE PATIENT AND THE ATTENDING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL OR THE PATIENT REPRESENTATIVE AND THE ATTENDING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL OR THE PATIENT REPRESENTATIVE AND THE ATTENDING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL HAVE SIGNED OR INITIALED THE POST FORM.
(B) THERE HAS BEEN AN UNEXPECTED CHANGE IN THE PATIENT'S MEDICAL CONDITION.
(C) THE PATIENT IS TRANSFERRED FROM 1 CARE SETTING OR CARE LEVEL TO ANOTHER CARE SETTING OR CARE LEVEL.
(D) THE PATIENT'S TREATMENT PREFERENCES CHANGE.
(FD) THE PATIENT'S ATTENDING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL CHANGES.
