SB 222 is a reintroduction of a bill the Family Law Section supported last term. It eliminates unmarried lewd and lascivious cohabitation from MCL 750.335, which is a misdemeanor. This is an anachronistic statute and the "crime" of cohabitation is occasionally raised as an issue in family law cases in an attempt to distract from the real issues. The Family Law Section supports this bill.
