ELDER LAW & DISABILITY RIGHTS SECTION Public Policy Position HB 5075 and SB 598

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is a voluntary membership section of the State Bar of Michigan, comprised of 1,262 members. The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Elder Law & Disability Rights Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. To date, the State Bar does not have a position on this item.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section has a public policy decision-making body with 19 members. On December 2, 2017, the Section adopted its position after discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 17 members voted in favor of the Section's position on HB 5075 & SB 598, 0 members voted against this position, 0 members abstained, 2 members did not vote.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section Opposes HB 5075 and SB 598.

Explanation:

The Section opposes both bills which are very similar.

The Proposed bills recommend changes to EPIC. And the changes may conflict with POST legislation signed by Governor in November 2017.
