At its July 22, 2011 meeting, the State Bar of Michigan's Board of Commissioners voted to oppose HB 4672 & HB 4673 as introduced. The Board supports the current and ongoing efforts to produce revised drafts of the bills that meet the following goals:

1. Incorporation of current statutory law;

2. Clarification of equitable factors relevant to judicial review;

3. Codification of existing case law pertaining to commonly recurring fact patterns;

4. Consideration of existing and pending uniform state laws;

5. Maintenance of judicial discretion;

Improving the predictability of outcomes in cases without individual agreements;

7. Identification of the circumstances, if any, under which a private agreement that conflicts with the statutes would be trumped by the statutes.

The State Bar's support for substitute bills reflects a position that positive policy changes can be made regarding the statutory instruction for division of property in divorce proceedings.
