At its January meeting, the State Bar of Michigan's Board of Commissioners unanimously voted to support SB 0246, SB 0247, HB 4555, and HB 4556 but respectfully requests an amendment be made regarding the qualifications of who performs a competency evaluation. An amendment was recommended by the Criminal Law Section that would state if a forensic mental health examiner if not available, the court should appoint another qualified person for the competency exam.

The position adopted by the State Bar was in concurrence with recommendations from the Criminal Law Section, the Criminal Jurisprudence & Practice Committee and the Justice Policy Initiative.
