Process used to take the ideological position: Vote of Council members at the meeting

Number of members in the decision-making body: 21

Number who voted in favor and opposed to the position: 12-1

Position:

The Family Law Section opposes HB 6280, which is one of several bills that would abolish dower. The Council finds that dower fills a useful purpose by requiring that a spouse have notice of any real estate transactions by the other spouse. This prevents fraud and dissipation of marital assets. The Council supported the idea of making dower gender neutral. The Council opposes this bill, and suggests that the sponsors seek to make dower gender neutral.
