HB 6417 (Zelenko) Family law; marriage and divorce; prerequisites for issuance of marriage license; require previously married individuals to present a final divorce decree. Amends sec. 3 of 1887 PA 128 (MCL 551.103).

Position:

HB 6417 requires persons applying for a marriage license to file a sworn statement indicating whether either party has been previously married. If so, the formerly married person must provide the County Clerk with a copy of their Judgment of Divorce. The purpose is to discourage bigamy. Marriage applicants can still lie on their sworn statement regarding previous marriages, but their intended may get suspicious if they do. The Council supports this bill, but suggests that the requirement of providing a judgment of divorce should also allow the production of a death certificate or an annulment.
