Position:

The Family Law Section opposes SB 1343 and 1344, which seek to abolish various aspects of dower. The Council finds that dower fills a useful purpose by requiring that a spouse have notice of any real estate transactions by the other spouse. This prevents fraud and dissipation of crucial marital assets. The Council supports the idea of making dower gender neutral. The Council opposes these bills, and suggests that the sponsors seek to make dower gender neutral.
