<u>SB 645</u> (Cherry) Family law; child support; use of substitute service for complaint under family support act; allow. Amends sec. 1 of <u>1966 PA 138</u> (MCL <u>552.451</u>).

Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

SB 645 deals with service of process in family support cases. It would permit service on non-resident defendant's by publication, posting notice in the courthouse, or any other method reasonably calculated to give the defendant actual notice of the action. These methods would not assure the court of the in personam jurisdiction necessary to sustain a support order, and could lead to an assertion of jurisdiction deemed unconstitutional under International Shoe and its progeny. The Family Law Section opposes this bill.
