<u>HB 5464</u> (Calley) Family law; parental rights; rights of putative father; require document notarization before termination. Amends sec. 37, ch. X of <u>1939 PA 288</u> (MCL <u>710.37</u>).

Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 5464 would require that in a termination proceeding a purported father's disclaimer of paternity or waiver of interest in the termination proceedings be notarized. This would make it more difficult to present a forged or fraudulent waiver, and would give greater finality to termination decisions. The Family Law Section supports this bill.
