The seminar will cover the process for obtaining veterans benefits, explain the reason benefits are denied, and discuss methods of appealing claim denials at the Board of Veterans Appeals and the Court of Appeals of Veterans Claims. Attorneys also will learn effective advocacy strategies in dealing with the Veterans Affairs system and will be briefed on recent developments in the area of veteran's law.

Continental breakfast and lunch are included at no charge to participants. In exchange for attending, participating attorneys will be asked to accept at least one veteran's law case on a pro bono basis. The training is sponsored by the University of Detroit Mercy School of Law Veterans Law Clinic, with support from the State Bar of Michigan and generous support and funding from the Michigan Legislature.
