



Free Naturalization Clinic: November 7, 2009

The *Kalamazoo County Bar Association Pro Bono Committee*, the *Diocese of Kalamazoo Immigration Assistance Program*, and the *Michigan Immigrant Rights Project* are sponsoring a free naturalization legal clinic on November 7, 2009. Lawful permanent residents who are eligible for U.S. citizenship will be able to meet with a volunteer lawyer to prepare and file their applications.

Who: Lawful Permanent Residents who have had their residency for four years and nine months, or, for two years and nine months if the spouse of a U.S. citizen; must be able to speak, read, and write English and pass civics test or qualify for a waiver of those requirements.
