WHAT: Special ribbon cutting ceremony to open the Crime Victims Rights Exhibit at the Michigan Supreme Court Learning Center. Chief Justice Robert P. Young, Jr., Senator Tonya Schuitmaker, former state legislator Senator Bill Van Regenmorter (author and proponent of Michigan's Crime Victims Rights Act), and Attorney General Bill Schuette are scheduled to speak.
