<u>SB 0459</u> (Emmons) Crimes; embezzlement; crime of obtaining signature by fraud and penalties for financial exploitation of vulnerable adults; increase under certain circumstances. Amends secs. 159g, 174a & 273 of <u>1931 PA</u> <u>328</u> (MCL <u>750.159g</u> et seq.).

<u>SB 0465</u> (Hildenbrand) Criminal procedure; sentencing guidelines; sentencing guidelines for crime of financial exploitation of vulnerable adult; revise to reflect increased penalties. Amends sec. 16i, ch. XVII of <u>1927 PA 175</u> (MCL <u>777.16i</u>).
