<u>HB 4472</u> (Pscholka) Corrections; parole; appointment of legal counsel for prisoner based upon appeal of parole by victim or prosecutor; prohibit under certain circumstances. Amends sec. 34 of <u>1953 PA 232</u> (MCL <u>791.234</u>).
