HB 5328 (Lori) Family law; paternity; acknowledgment of parentage; allow to be set aside under revocation of paternity act. Amends sec. 7 of 1996 PA 305 (MCL 722.1007) & repeals sec. 11 of 1996 PA 305 (MCL 722.1011).

<u>HB 5329</u> (Somerville) Family law; paternity; order of filiation; allow to be set aside under revocation of paternity act. Amends sec. 10 of <u>1956 PA 205</u> (MCL <u>722.720</u>).
