SB 530 updates the FOC act to refer to collection and disbursement by the SDU, and refers to DHS and OCS as the IV-D agency, which allows for future changes without revisiting the statute. It also replaces references to ADR with Domestic Relations mediation, and strikes the separate FOC qualifications in favor of the SCAO standards. The Family Law Section supports this bill.
