HB 4180 would enact a uniform power of attorney act. The ELDR Section Council opposes the legislation because it believes that the positive changes to existing law contained in the legislation are significantly outweighed by provisions that are problematic and likely to create more problems than they solve. The Council believes that any proposed legislation affecting powers of attorneys should await the recommendations of the Probate and Estate Planning Section's committee that has undertaken a comprehensive review of the Uniform Power of Attorney Act..
