<u>HB 6265</u> (Espinoza) Family law; parenting time; great-grandparenting time; provide for. Amends secs. 2 & 7b of 1970 PA 91 (MCL 722.22 & 722.27b).

## Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 6265 would expand the grandparenting time statute to apply to great-grandparents as well. This would add eight potential contestants for a child's time, and would only be useful for great-grandparents who could not obtain derivative visitation through their children or grandchildren. Any potential benefit of gaining great-grandparenting time over the objection of the parent is outweighed by adding contestants and layers of conflict to the child's life. The Family Law Section opposes this bill.
