<u>HB 4704</u> (Byrnes) Family law; marriage and divorce; change of name procedure whenever decree of divorce is granted; revise to make gender neutral. Amends title & sec. 1 of <u>1905 PA 299</u> (MCL <u>552.391</u>).

Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 4704 is a reintroduction of a bill that the Family Law Section previously supported. It allows husbands to obtain a restoration or change of name upon divorce under the same conditions that wives obtain these changes. This makes the statute gender neutral and provides relief to couples who hyphenated their last names at marriage. The Family Law Section supports this bill.
