## Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 4312 and 4470 are identical bills providing that any company that allows parental leave on the birth of a child must also allow adoption leave for parents of a child under five years of age. The challenges of assimilating a young adoptive child into a household are as great as assimilating a new baby. This bill gives adoptive parents an equal opportunity to successfully integrate a new child into their household. The Family Law Section supports this bill.
