# Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

House Joint Resolution L proposes a constitutional amendment to eliminate term limits for state representatives and senators. Term limits have proven to be bad policy. They have eliminated the voter's choice to retain qualified representatives. By limiting the experience of legislators, term limits have eroded the institutional memory of the house and senate, allowing bad legislation to be reintroduced every time the legislature turns over. The Family Law Section supports this resolution.
