<u>HB 5715</u> (Spade) Family law; child support; annual child support fee; impose. Amends title & secs. 3 & 6 of <u>1971</u> <u>PA 174</u> (MCL <u>400.233</u> & <u>400.236</u>).

Date position was adopted: February 6, 2010

Position: Support and Amend

Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 5715 provides statutory authorization for the federal requirement that states assess a \$25 annual fee against a recipient of support who has never received TANF benefits, after the first \$500 dollars is collected in that year. The bill should refer to "recipient of support" rather than "individuals" and should clarify that the \$500 is an annual collection requirement. The Family Law Section supports the bill if these amendments are made.
