In our efforts to offer a wider range of resources to Michigan lawyers, we are always interested in new opportunities to collaborate with Bar Sections. Collaboration with ICLE offers many opportunities to develop resources for members and greater exposure for your Section. Many opportunities are free for Sections and others are fee-based. Seminars

One of the easiest ways to collaborate with ICLE is to cosponsor an ICLE Partnership seminar in your Section’s practice area. You would work with us to develop the topics and recommend speakers. Section members receive a discount on the registration fee, and those who are ICLE Partners can attend the seminar free. Because ICLE promotes the seminar beyond Section membership, this is an excellent way to increase the visibility of your Section. Partnership seminars are generally offered for live attendance and live webcast, so that lawyers across the state can attend.
