By order of October 30, 2024, the application for leave to appeal the August 17, 2023 judgment of the Court of Appeals was held in abeyance pending the decisions in *People v Czarnecki* (Docket No. 166654) and *People v Taylor* (Docket No. 166428). On order of the Court, *Czarnecki* and *Taylor* having been decided on April 10, 2025, \_\_\_ Mich \_\_\_ (2025), the application is again considered. Pursuant to MCR 7.305(I)(1), in lieu of granting leave to appeal, we REMAND this case to the Court of Appeals for reconsideration of the defendant's challenge to the constitutionality of his life-without-parole sentence for conspiracy to commit first-degree murder based on his age in light of *Taylor*. In all other respects, leave to appeal is DENIED, because we are not persuaded that the remaining questions presented should be reviewed by this Court.


