On order of the Court, the application for leave to appeal the January 18, 2024 judgment of the Court of Appeals is considered and, pursuant to MCR 7.305(H)(1), in lieu of granting leave to appeal, we VACATE Part II of the judgment of the Court of Appeals regarding whether the trial court erred by admitting into evidence certain statements made by the victim. We REMAND this case to the Court of Appeals for reconsideration of whether the verified statements in support of the petition for a personal protection order were testimonial in light of People v Washington, 514 Mich , (July 26, 2024) (Docket No. 165296); slip op at 8, and whether the victim's statements to his girlfriend and other children were admissible under MRE 803(3) in light of this Court's January 22, 2025 order in *People v Propp*, Mich (2025) (Docket No. 164313). In all other respects, leave to appeal is DENIED, because we are not persuaded that the remaining questions presented should be reviewed by this Court.

We do not retain jurisdiction.
