On order of the Court, the application for leave to appeal the July 16, 2025 judgment of the Court of Appeals is considered and, pursuant to MCR 7.305(I)(1), in lieu of granting leave to appeal, we REMAND this case to the Court of Appeals for reconsideration in light of *In re Petition of Kent Co Treasurer for Foreclosure*, ___ Mich App ___ (March 21, 2025) (Docket No. 363463), to address an issue that it did not address during its initial review of this case regarding whether petitioner failed to provide respondents with constitutionally adequate notice of their right to claim surplus proceeds. In all other respects, leave to appeal is DENIED, because we are not persuaded that the remaining questions presented should be reviewed by this Court.

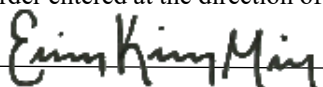
We do not retain jurisdiction.
