

Bylaws of the Workers' Compensation Law Section of the State Bar of Michigan

At a regularly scheduled council meeting held February 1, 2013, a quorum of members voted unanimously to adopt the following amendment to allow e-mail voting.

ARTICLE V DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE COUNCIL

SECTION 6. The Chairperson of the Section at any time may, and upon the request of any member of the Council shall, submit or cause to be submitted in writing (including electronically), to each

of the members of the Council, any proposition upon which the Council may be authorized to act, and the members of the Council may vote upon such proposition or propositions so submitted, by communicating their vote thereon, in writing (including electronically) over their respective signatures, to the Secretary, who shall record ~~upon his/her minutes each proposition so submitted, when, how, at whose request same was submitted, and the vote of each member of Council thereon, and keep on file such written and signed votes.~~ the results. If the ~~recorded~~ so recorded votes of a majority of the members of the Council shall be in favor of such propositions or if such majority shall be against such proposition, such majority vote shall constitute the binding action of the Council.
