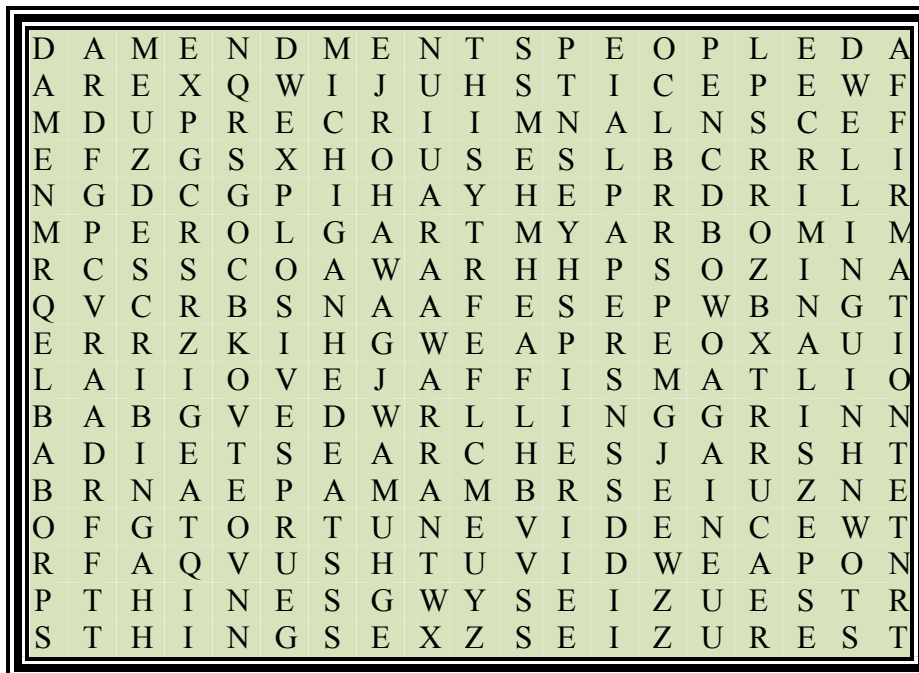


FOURTH AMENDMENT
