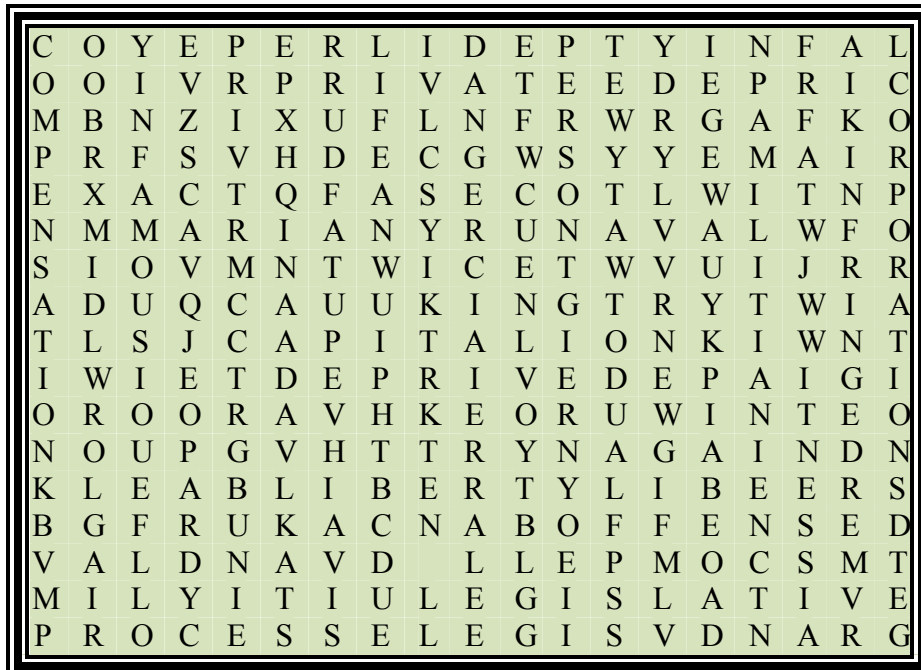


FIFTH AMENDMENT
