 - b) Checks made out to transfer funds between State Bar of Michigan accounts;
 - c) Checks made out to Ameritas, Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Michigan, PHP, Paul Goebel Group, Vision Service Plan (VSP), Fortis and Boston Mutual for staff insurance benefits;
 - d) Checks made out to SBM Deferred Compensation Plan and State of Michigan Retirement System for routine retirement contribution payments.
 - e) Checks made out to Postmaster, Lansing to replenish our postage meter, bulk and postage-paid permit accounts.

Authorize the Assistant Executive Director of Finance to transfer funds by telephone among SBM cash and investment accounts as may be appropriate to have adequate cash in checking account to meet cash flow needs;

Authorize the Treasurer to invest any surplus funds over and above those necessary for current operating expenses in accordance with the investment policy.
