Changes in technology have reshaped how free speech and free press work in the everyday world.

TOPIC:

Create a poster showing your favorite champion (defender/supporter) of free speech.

TEACHERS NOTE: As your students prepare for this contest, we encourage you to have conversations with your students to understand why the student has a particular person as their champion of free speech and what that person has done.

Artwork should be a minimum of 8.5" x 11" up to a maximum of 22" x 28" and submitted along with the attached Entry Form. We encourage students to have fun and be creative!
