MCRC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Court Eligibility Criteria: (1) Age 17 or older; (2) Legal resident of the United States; (3) Resident of Muskegon County; (3) Has pled guilty to all original charges; (5) No pending charges in another jurisdiction and no outstanding bench warrants; (6) Not on probation/parole in another jurisdiction; (7) A link exists between current offense and use of drugs or alcohol.

Legal Eligibility Criteria: (1) <u>Defendant's prior record shall not include:</u> (a) CSC – first degree, second degree, or third degree; (b) Any assaultive felony (except Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer); (c) More than two delivery, manufacture, or possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance charges; (d) Any felony offense involving a firearm. (2) <u>Defendant's current charges shall not include:</u> (a) Any offense involving death or serious bodily injury to an individual whether or not any of the circumstances are an element of the offense, or an offense that is criminal sexual conduct of any degree. MCL 600.1060(g); (b) Any assaultive felony (except Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer); (c) Delivery, manufacture, or possession with intent to deliver methamphetamine or heroin; (d) Any offense involving use of a firearm; (e) Home Invasion first degree.

The prosecutor has discretion to disapprove an applicant for reasons not listed above, however, any applicant whose referral is disapproved by the Prosecutor may still request that the sentencing Judge order him or her to participate in the MCRC at the time of sentencing.

In cases where participation would make the applicant eligible for (1) discharge or dismissal of an offense, (2) delayed sentence, or (3) deviation from the sentencing quidelines, the Prosecutor has statutory authority to veto such participation. See MCL 600.1068(2).

Clinical Eligibility Criteria: (1) Qualify for substance use treatment at the level of Intensive Outpatient (IOP) or higher; (2) No physical health conditions that requires continuous management with a controlled substance; (3) No mental health condition that requires continuous management with a controlled substance; (4) No severe and persistent mental health diagnosis or significant cognitive impairment.
