

AFFIDAVIT OF CRIMINAL HISTORY

Review the Required Third Party Information Instructions, located on Step 3, prior to completing this form.

This Affidavit will satisfy the criminal history report requirement for a limited number of states that do not provide reports for bar application purposes, and for all foreign countries. A separate form must be completed for each applicable state or country. **Note: This form must be notarized, and is NOT valid for Michigan.**
