# Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

SB 257 requires all marriage license applicants to provide the County Clerk with extensive identification information for themselves and for their intended spouse. This is burdensome for the County Clerk and for the applicants, serves no useful purpose, and is a bureaucratic impediment to marriage. The Family Law Section opposes this bill.
