<u>HB 4382</u> (Cotter) Health; emergency response; do-not-resuscitate orders; authorize guardians to execute and provide other general amendments. Amends title & secs. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 14 of 1996 PA 193 (MCL 333.1052 et seq.) & adds sec. 3a.

<u>HB 4383</u> (LaFontaine) Human services; adult foster care; citation to do-not-resuscitate orders; revise. Amends sec. 4 of <u>1979 PA 218</u> (MCL <u>400.704</u>).

## HB 4384 (Kurtz)

Probate; guardians and conservators; guardian's authority to consent to a do-not-resuscitate order; clarify, and provide procedure. Amends secs. 1103, 5303, 5305 & 5314 of 1998 PA 386 (MCL 700.1103) et seq.).
