### **Position:**

The CLS voted 16 to 0 to OPPOSE this bill for the following reasons:

- This bill would likely have little, if any, positive effect because:
  - a) This bill would only provide a subtle change in the Child Protection Law's requirement of when DHS shall request to the assistance of law enforcement and when DHS shall file a petition.
  - b) This bill has no effect on when DHS <u>may</u> request the assistance of law enforcement and when DHS <u>may</u> file a petition.
  - c) This bill has no effect on the Juvenile Code or the related court rules, which dictate when the court may take jurisdiction of children and when they can be removed them from their parents.
