Position:

HB 4542 introduced by Reps. Robertson, Brandenburg, Pastor, Garfield, Marleau and Byrnes and referred to Judiciary, would provide for graduated penalties for criminal non-support. The penalties would be based on amount owed or duration of non-payment. The Council did not think that the current criminal statute, which allows a conviction without any evidence of past or current ability to pay, was appropriate. The graduated penalties were seen as a slight improvement to an unfair situation. The Council felt that it would be better if the amounts owed were evaluated in relation to the amount ordered, i.e., owing \$3,000 on a \$300 per month order was more egregious than \$3,000 on a \$3,000 per month order. The Council voted to support the bill and offer the suggested amendment.
